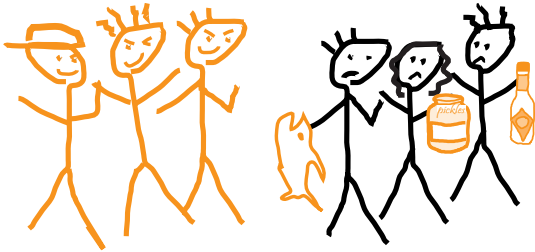

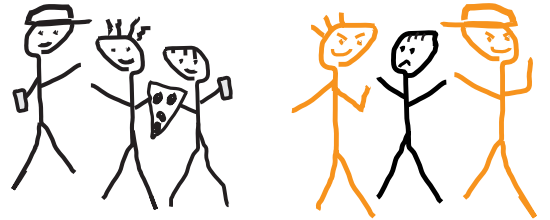

here!"



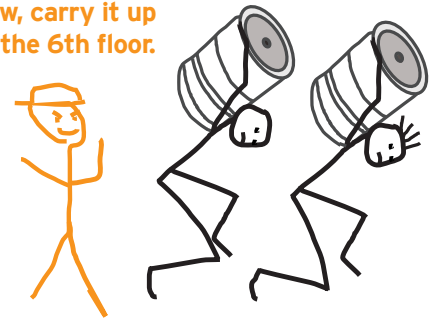

## acts of servitude

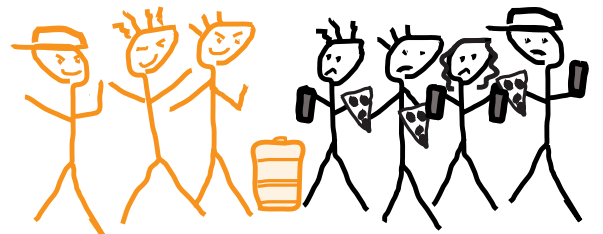
