Like many campuses and metropolitan areas, STIs are on the rise at Cornell. Students using ONLINE HOOK-UP APPS have been particularly affected.

- **BE SEX SMART**: You usually can't "tell by looking" if someone is infected with an STI. Symptoms may not be present.
