We're here for you

Cornell Health provides whole-person medical and mental health services for students of all sexual orientations, gender identities, and expressions. Our staff members collaborate with Cornell's LGBT Resource Center to support our ability to deliver welcoming, inclusive, and culturally sensitive services and support.

We aim to create an environment in which you feel empowered to discuss your needs and concerns with your health care provider so we can provide you with the best care possible.

Cornell Health services

- Primary care medical services, with each student assigned to their own Primary Care Provider throughout their time at Cornell
- Inclusive sexual health care including safersex resources, PrEP, PEP, STI/HIV screening and treatment, and contraception
- Gender-affirming care including hormone therapy, official letters for gender marker changes and name changes, surgical referrals, and preand post-operative care
- Pharmacy services including prescription and non-prescription medication, sexual health and self-care supplies, and chest binders
- Individual counseling with the ability to request

Health & safer sex supplies

Available at Cornell Health:

- Free condoms and lube
- Prescriptions for HIV prevention (PrEP and PEP) and antiviral treatment, gender-affirming hormone therapy, and long-acting contraception (IUD, pills, shot, etc.)
- Safer sex supplies (including condoms/barriers, and lube), non-prescription emergency contraception ("Plan B"), and menstrual products and other personal care items available for sale in the pharmacy
- High-quality chest binders (2 free binders per student each semester) in the pharmacy

Available (for free!) at the LGBT Resource Center, Women's Resource Center, and Loving House:

- External condoms, internal condoms, latex squares (aka "dental dams"), and lube
