Cornell Health offers medical and mental health services to students who are non-binary, transgender, questioning their gender identity, and those considering gender transition (medically or surgically).

#### Services

Following the guidance of the World Professional Association for Transgender Health (WPATH), our providers who specialize in transgender care can provide you with...

- · counseling and support related to gender identity
- medical care for the initiation and management of gender-affirming hormones
- high-quality chest binders (free to students!)
- a letter of support and care coordination before and after gender-affirming surgical procedures
- pre-operative testing and post-operative care
- official letters for gender marker changes and name changes
